New Materials in Dentistry

8:30am to 12:30pm (4CE hours)

This course will discuss many of the new hot materials in dentistry including bulk-fill composites, universal adhesives, zirconia primers, hydrophilic impression materials and more. This course is not sponsored by any manufacturer, so you will get an unbiased view of a variety of products from a variety of manufacturers. Most of the information presented in this course has come from the clinical and materials research areas of UAB, so the information is straight from the source. The categories covered in this course include: ceramics, composites, adhesive, cements, impression materials and metals. We will discuss the advantages of these new materials as well as their limitations. We will also discuss clinical techniques that have been shown to make these materials more effective.

Oral Health Care of HIV/AIDS Patients (counts as Infection Control)

1:00pm to 3:00pm (2 CE Hours)

HIV infection and AIDS is a worldwide epidemic cutting through barriers of race, gender and age. Approximately sixteen thousand patients currently are affected by this infection in the state of Alabama. This course focuses on the epidemiology, etiology, modes of transmission, oral manifestations and their management in HIV-infected patients. In addition, considerations when performing dental procedures in this patient population will be discussed. Drugs used in the treatment of HIV/AIDS and their impact on oral health will be presented. The course will also encompass principles of infection control, post-exposure prophylaxis for occupational injury and HIV/Hepatitis C co-infection.
